TO: Parents

The following health requirements for non-Los Encinos students/ campers:

1. **TUBERCULOSIS EXAMINATION**

The following categories of children are required to submit written documentation of a TB skin test performed within one year prior to the start of camp:

- (a) All children entering kindergarten.
- (b) All new students entering grades 1-6.

The required test is the Mantoux Method. Please have your doctor note the date given, the date read and the result, on your child's **YELLOW CALIFORNIA IMMUNIZATION RECORD**.

2. **CHILDREN MUST SHOW WRITTEN PROOF OF THE FOLLOWING IMMUNIZATIONS:**

- 4 Polio -OPV or IPV
- 5 DPT/DTaP/DT/Td
- 3 Hepatitis B
- 2 MMR (both on or after 1st birthday)
- 1 Varicella (Chicken Pox)

3. **MEDICAL HEALTH EXAMINATION**

Children are required to show written proof of a doctor's health examination. The date for the exam must be within 18 months prior to June enrollment. A note from your doctor constitutes sufficient proof of the child's health examination during the last year and a half.

4. **RECORD OF IMMUNIZATIONS**

****Please bring your Yellow California Immunization Record or send a copy to the school office****

All non-Los Encinos School students must meet the above requirements by the opening day of Camp Los Encinos.

Children who fail to meet the above requirements by their first day of camp may be denied admission or may be admitted on a conditional basis, subject to securing proof of testing within 1 day. After that grace period, non-compliance will result in the child being denied admission until the testing is completed.
